
Fees and Charges for 2021/2022

Council previously have had a fee of \$30.00 for this though haven't enforced it, therefore the fee has now been reduced to a basic cost recovery.

CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

Swimming Pool

STAGE ONE

Construction of the pools new plant and pump room is now complete and operational providing the facility with;

- ·New chlorination pump;
- ·New balance tank;
- ·Chlorine Storage facilities;
- ·Dry store for pump and plant operations;
- ·Yard store for access to facilities; and
- ·Aquatic Club storage facility.

STAGE TWO

Tenders have been received for the construction of stage two works which include;

- ·Changerooms
- ·Meeting Room & First Aid Room;
- ·Kiosk and BBQ Area


Council is working through the process for awarding the tender with works expected to commence towards the latter part of this calendar year.

STAGE THREE

Council has made an application to the Federal Government through the Building Better Regions Round 5 funding for:

- ·New 25m pool
- ·Learn to swim pool
- ·Water play leisure pool incorporating a zero beach enter including disability access
- ·Grassed areas for viewing.

Council is hopeful to hear the results of this application by mid to late August 2021.

CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

Bush Fire Sheds

The construction of the sheds is progressing very well with the structures complete at all three sites. The internal fitouts are currently being completed with works expected to be completed by August/September 2021.

Exhibition Hall – Royal Ag Show Funding.

The Exhibition Hall Construction is 95% complete with the final trimmings and some minor corrections taking place over the next week.

A massive shout out to the Sport and Recreation members who have attended two busy bees to have the gyprock removed off the hallway wall and install the gyprock to the exhibition hall side wall. This work has expedited the construction process to ensure that we have the entire process completed by the end of August.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT FLECTIONS

Local government elections are held every two years, with the next Election being held on Saturday 16th October 2021. Nominations open on Thursday 2nd September and close at 4pm on Thursday 9th September.

The Shire of Kellerberrin will have three (3) vacancies, each for a 4-year term this Election. Further information on Council Elections is available from CEO Raymond Griffiths.

Prospective candidates are encouraged to regularly check the DLGSC website for updates about induction requirements and other matters related to the local elections.
