WHATS BEEN HAPPENING AROUND THE SHIRE? CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

Exhibition Hall

The Shire of Kellerberrin is assisting the Kellerberrin Agricultural Society with the construction of the new Exhibition Hall funded through the Royal Agricultural Funding and Kellerberrin Recreation and Leisure Centre Management Committee.

The shed structure us nearing completion. The shed is being constructed on the grounds and then lifted into place. Once the shed is standing the walls and rollers door are to be fitted completing the shed structure enabling the lighting, fire warning system and gyprocking of the brick wall to be completed.

Swimming Pool

The construction works are progressing well with all ground works and balance tank construction complete. The contractors are now finalising the shed construction that will house the new pumps and plant.

On completion of this project the pool will have;

- · New pump for the chlorination of pool;
- · New balance tank;
- Chlorine storage facilities;
- · Dry store for pump & plant operations;
- · Yard store for access to facilities; and
- · Aquatic Club storage facility.

Stage two of the pool construction (change rooms, meeting room, kiosk & BBQ area) is currently being prepared for tender advertising. This facility will act as a dual purpose facility for the Hockey Club enabling suitable toilets and changerooms facilities and access to kiosk facilities.

Council is still waiting on advice for its Stage 3 application through BBRF Round 5 to fund the replacement of the current pools with a 25m lap pool, upgrading the existing shallow pool facilities to incorporate a learn to swim (LTS) pool, water play leisure pool with zero beach entry including disability access and the development of recreational amenities including lawned picnic areas and a shaded barbeque facility.
