**Title:** Call-out of Tenders Outside of Brigade Area

### 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure a system is in place for cost recovery in the event of a call out outside of the Shire of Kellerberrin Jurisdiction.

### 5. POLICY STATEMENT

If a Brigade tender is called out for use by WA Fire and Rescue Volunteers or Police or any other organisation to assist in an accident situation outside of Bush Fire jurisdiction or outside of Kellerberrin, costs for this exercise will be attempted to be recovered by the Shire administration on behalf of that Brigade. The Shire will not be responsible for the costs.

If a Brigade chooses not to utilise its own tender, and calls out a tender from another Brigade unit, that unit making the request will be responsible for costs of the callout to the Brigade supplying the unit.
