



## COUNCIL POLICY

**Title:** Collection of Seeds from Road Reserves

### 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure there is consistency in permitting the collection of seeds from road reserves.

### 2. SCOPE

This policy is applied to the Shire of Kellerberrin Community.

### 5. POLICY STATEMENT

Council may grant permission for seed to be collected from Shire Reserves and Road Reserves provided:

1. Applicant must show proof of a current DER licence
2. 10 per cent of any seed collected is to be provided to the Shire of Kellerberrin at no charge and the designated species to be collected is to be agreed upon.
3. Permission is valid for 12 months
4. Permits expire in conjunction with DER licences.
5. There is to be no destruction of flora and fauna associated with the collection of seeds
6. The Shire of Kellerberrin to be advised on a weekly basis when picking is in progress, species being picked and the location of picking. This is to be recorded in a log book by the Shire.
7. An administration fee of \$50 to apply for the annual permit to collect seed from Council reserves and road reserves.
