### 5. POLICY STATEMENT

That the Shire of Kellerberrin adopts the following Policy in relation to the use of the Shire's trotting facilities, on occasions other than Racing Wagering Western Australia (RWWA) race days;

- a. To use the facility at the Greater Sports Ground other than race meeting days, the user must be a member of the Central Wheatbelt Harness Racing Club Inc. Use will only be permitted when the member is wearing safety equipment e.g. approved safety helmet and safety footwear.
- b. Users of the airstrip trotting tracks will be required to use the facility wearing safety equipment.
- c. Council accepts no liability for the use of the Shire trotting facilities by persons who are unauthorised users or do not comply with Council's rules in relation to the use of safety equipment.
