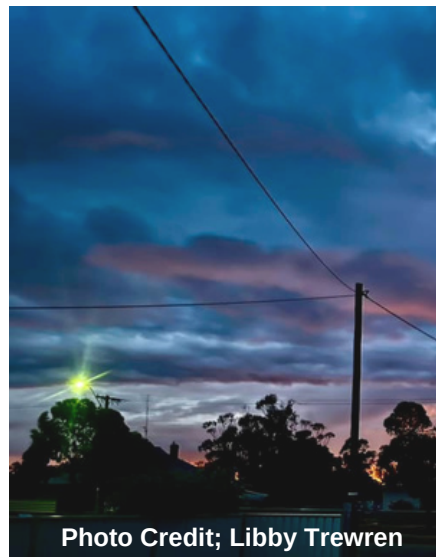

Council are also working on Z-card brochures for additional promotion of Kellerberrin, its businesses, tourist spots and the region.

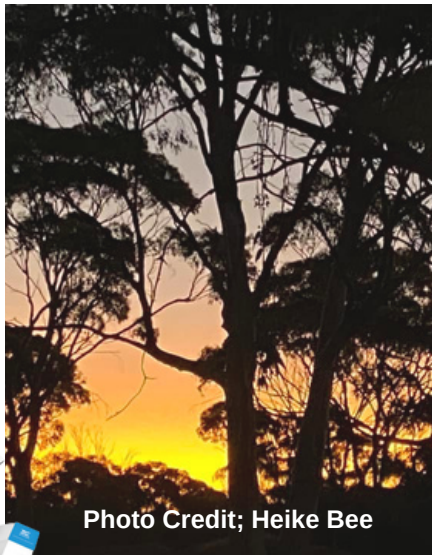

Shire of Kellerberrin 2023/2024 Road Program

Regional Road Group

- Doodlakine South Road—5.97 SLK to 7.90SLK(Full Reconstruction)
- Doodlakine South Road—Reseal of the following sections;
 - 0.86–1.45
 - 2.80–5.17
 - 5.49–5.95
- Doodlakine South Road—Clearing Permit Application for 9.70–12.45 SLK.
- Kellerberrin Yelbini Road—Clearing Permit Application

Commodity Route Funding

Goldfields Road—3.37 SLK-4.87 SLK (Highway heading east 1.5 kms)(Carryover funding from 2022/2023)

- Goldfields Road—4.87–5.77 SLK

Roads to Recovery

Council has allocated the following works to its Roads to Recovery program;

- Sewell Street—Highway to back lane
- Connelly Street—Reconstruct between Hinckley and Moore Street

Local Community Roads Infrastructure Program – Region and Rural Roads Program

Reconstruct Hammond Street from Scott Street to Restdown St intersection renewal. Works include new road surface, kerbing and footpath construction.

Road Maintenance

Council is currently working on shoulder grading on its sealed roads to ensure the edges of the seal is maintained and provides a safe road edge for road users.

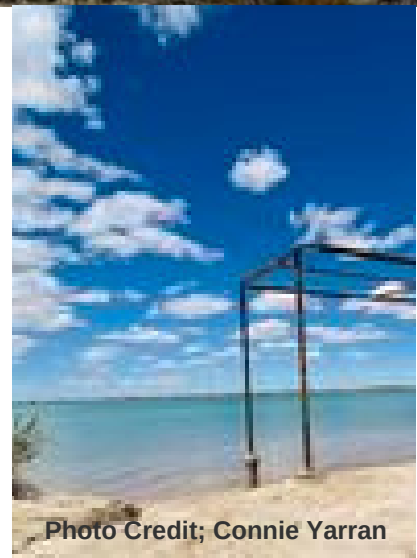

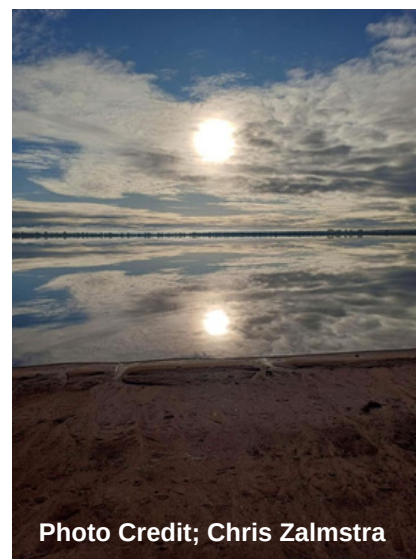

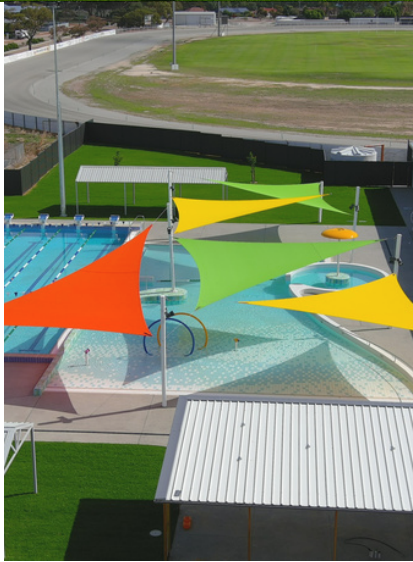




KELLERBERRIN FACILITIES UPDATE

Kellerberrin Memorial Swimming Pool Redevelopment

Construction of the pool is complete and Council staff are currently finalising the licence requirements to ensure the pool is ready for the new pool season.



Swimming Pool Carpark

Council is planning for the construction of a new Car Park for the new Swimming Pool. In the construction of the car park the drainage on Hinckley Street (roadside) and Gregory Street intersection will be upgraded with concrete to replace the current damaged sections. The proposed car park will provide 60+ bays for the community to access when utilising the Swimming Pool and/or Hockey Oval facility.

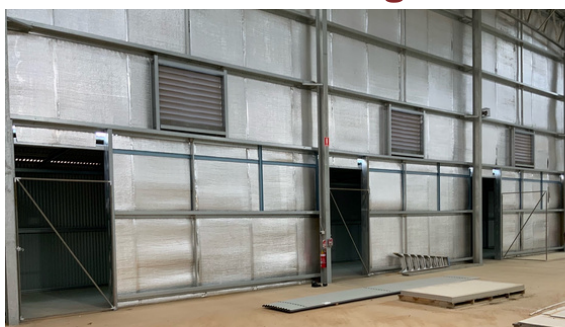
The car park will also include items from the old pool complex as a reminder of the previous facility.



Official Opening

Exhibition Hall - Storage Shed



The construction of the storage facility at the Eastern End of the Exhibition Hall contains five (5) 7.2m x 3.5m bays for the Kellerberrin Agricultural Society and Sporting clubs to utilise as storage for all their equipment.
